3. **Review of Stage 2 Survey results**

The group expressed the pleasing result overall. There had been a very positive response with a good split across the area and age groups in general.

The documents summarising the quantitative and qualitative information were shared and general discussion followed. In general there was a view the results reflected the local picture, however there were some questions where the results were a surprise. In particular there was a view that the concerns relating to crime were often “perceptions” and do not necessarily reflect the reality of the position.

4. **Activity 1 – Review whether the issue is for the neighbourhood Plan and/or Stantonbury Parish Council Strategy**

The group then reviewed the document completed by the NP Committee at the workshop on 17th May. Additional comments were reflected and added, but general consensus was reached regarding those to be addressed in the Plan.

5. **Activity 2 – Land use identification and potential allocation/designation**

The group reviewed the map prepared by the Neighbourhood Plan Committee and discussion was held on the more detailed mapping required.

The estate by estate maps will be prepared to highlight the potential areas for development/protection and will be further reviewed at the next meeting.

Discussion was held around the potential for redevelopment of the shops at Purbeck – it was suggested we do not need to be specific but keep the wording general with regard the support for smaller shops.

The car park area opposite Heron Lodge at Stantonbury Fields was also discussed as a good location for a community centre/office for SPC.

6. **Policy Development**

The broad policy themes were discussed and LE explained the detailed policies will be drawn up with the support of a Planning Consultant. A meeting is to be held in the near future with the MKC Planning Support

Officer where we will review any additional evidence required to support the proposed policies.
