Minutes of Main Meeting of Stantonbury Parish Council Held at **7.30 pm on Wednesday 20th April 2016** At Stantonbury Parish Office, 126 Kingsfold, Bradville

15 minute session for members of the public to speak

In view of the serious nature of the following item, it has been decided full disclosure of names and discussions will appear on these minutes:

Mr Stanton, 29 Westhill and Mr Lagodzski, 31 Westhill, Stantonbury came to talk about amenity land and parking issues on Westhill, Stantonbury after previously emailing the Parish Council. Mr Stanton opened the discussion stating that the residents wanted to work with the Parish Council to find a solution to the parking issues in Westhill.

It was proposed by Cllr B Lark and Seconded by Cllr L Morgan to move forward 09/16 to discuss this in further detail with the residents. For the benefit of the full council Cllr Davison summarised the discussions and event leading to tonight's meeting.

- Cllr Davison met with Mr Stanton in December and explained why the Parish Council were putting out the parking infringement notices around the parish.
- At that meeting Mr Stanton had proposed the use of Grasscrete as a parking solution. Cllr Davison confirmed that this had been considered and rejected by the Parish Council. Nothing was heard on the matter until April 2016.
- A resident from Westhill complained to Milton Keynes Council (MKC) and drew both MKC and our attention to the fact that public amenity land had been dug up and hard-core and paving had been put down to extend parking in Westhill.
- Cllr Davison visited the resident and was directed to number 31
 Westhill to see the extent of the work.
- Cllr Davison spoke with Mrs Stanton (29 Westhill) who confirmed that the residents of the four houses were responsible for digging up the grass areas. She stated that this action had occurred because neither MK Council nor the Parish Council had taken any

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- action to resolve the parking problems. She passed on an email from Milton Keynes Council parking department where it was stated that "Grasscrete" was a viable option for parking on grass.
- Mrs Stepping's (MKC) had written to the residents to say that Grasscrete may be OK to put down for parking, the Parish Council had been forwarded these emails and the Councillors had copies.
- Mr Stanton confirmed that he had converted the edges of the drive over to a hard-core standing because Mr Stanton has adult children so needs more parking. He asserted that this was acceptable to Milton Keynes Council. Cllr Davison read an email response from Mr Proctor of MK Council 18 April 2016 regarding the taking of this amenity land and pointed out that the council will be negotiating in the first instance to get the land reinstated.
- Mr Stanton asked whether MKC could change the public amenity land all the way down Westhill into car parking spaces.
- Mr Lagodzski said his parking problem was because he lived in a HIMO and insufficient parking spaces were available on the property.
- Cllr Davison said that neither we nor the council could afford to provide additional parking spaces for Westhill.
- Cllr Davison advised that all over Stantonbury and MK in general had the same issues with parking and land grabbing was not the solution.
- Cllr Davison said he was happy to have a public meeting with all residents of Westhill to find a solution to the parking problem.
- Mr Stanton was far from happy as he saw his actions were a solution and that the Parish Council were not happy to accept this as a solution.
- Cllr Davison said that the Parish Council would not sanction grabbing of public amenity land for this purpose.
