	<p>15 minute session for members of the public to speak</p> <p>Residents from Stantonbury complained about a family at Stowe Court, language is obscene and can be heard from streets away. They are allowing their young children to run around the roads, climb onto the shed roofs and use foul language to passing public, these children are reported to be between 3 and 10. There is also rubbish dumped at the end of these houses. Residents from nearby streets are having to close their windows at the weekend in order not to hear it. The children have taken over the front of the house and the paths with toys so people cannot walk past and people with mobility scooters have to go onto the green amenity space at the front of the houses. Both Cllrs Kennedy and Agintas have had to do this. These Councillors have indicated that they would help keep an eye on the situation.</p> <p>The residents were advised to evidence gather as there is little the Parish Council can do without it, reporting to environmental health would be the way forward.</p> <p>Ward Councillors were invited to attend tonight but only 1 responded with an apology.</p>
