## Macmillan Coffee Morning

A definite date for the diary, Stantonbury Parish Council are holding a Coffee Morning at 11 o'clock at our offices (126 Kingsfold, Bradville, MK13 7DX). We understand speeding is a big issue for street safety so we're actively working to monitor speeds and make improvements based on the data we collect.

We look after our streets through two primary means: TSID and Sentinel.

We look after our streets through two primary means: TSID and Sentinel. TSIDs are temporary vehicle-activated signs which detect and display real-time vehicle speeds (left). Our TSID spends four weeks at one location, two weeks facing in either direction. This data helps us to understand where the busiest roads are in our Parish and where we need to focus on. We have also purchased a Sentinel Device to monitor speeds and note vehicle registrations of those who violate speed limits, working alongside Thames Valley Police. This will be rolled out in the coming month and will be seen around the Parish soon! To see the data we collected, please have a look on our website.
