Parish Rangers



Stantonbury Parish Council has two Parish Rangers, Lee and Paul, who are both integral parts in keeping the Parish running. Not only are they a point of contact for residents, they also make regular visits to the allotments and hold litter picks with Parish Guardians to keep our streets clean. Importantly, they conduct daily walk-round checks of different estates compiling information on issues which are then sorted in-office or passed to Milton Keynes Council. One such issue raised was overgrown hedges which encroached onto walkways and covered important signage. Once informed, the office scheduled time for our Rangers to trim the hedges back and make the walkway more usable. As you can see, the before (top) and after (bottom) results are striking!

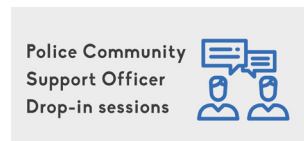
