Every Thursday the Neighbourhood Employment Programme runs a drop-in

Job Club 1-3pm in our offices where any residents can come in for impartial advice and guidance, CV building, help with job searches, interview workshops, access to free work-related training courses, and more. Every 6 weeks we also hold a drop-in session with Thames Valley Police
