### Consultation on the Proposal to Retain SNP 14, SNP 16, and SNP 17

Following the return of the Examiner's Report with the advisement that policies SNP14, SNP16 and SNP17 should be deleted, Milton Keynes Council reviewed these policies and believe they should be retained, with amendments. As such, a consultation will be held again for public comments. The consultation on the proposed decision to retain the amended policies SNP14, SNP16 & SNP17 is available for comments for 8 weeks from Wednesday 20th November, 2019 to Wednesday 15th January 2020.
