COUNCILLORS' ALLOWANCES - SCHEME OF ALLOWANCES

FOR THE REMUNERATION OF COUNCILLORS IN THE STANTONBURY PARISH

This Notice is published in accordance with [Regulation 16\(1\) of the Local Authorities \(Members' Allowances\) \(England\) Regulations 2003](#).

The Council, on 18 May 2022, agreed to adopt a scheme of Councillors' Allowances for the year 2022/23 and, in doing so, gave due regard to the recommendations made by the report of the Independent Remuneration Panel for Milton Keynes Parish and Town Councils in December 2021.

The scheme will apply from 01 May 2022, unless amended or revoked, until 30 April 2023.

The Council's Scheme of Allowances 2022/23

The allowances payable to councillors have increased by 11.6% compared to those paid in 2021/22 in accordance with the recommendations of the Independent Remuneration Panel for Milton Keynes Parish and Town Councils in December 2021. No other changes have been made to the scheme.

The main elements of the scheme are the payment of a Basic Allowance of £837 per annum to each elected Member of the Council and the payment of £1675 to the Chair of the Council.

Allowance and Expenses Payments made in 2021/22

The Council is required to make available the amounts paid to each councillor in respect of the Councillor Allowances and Expenses for the previous year. A record of the amounts paid during 2021/22 are available for inspection at the Parish Office and on the Council's [website](#).
