COUNCILLOR ALLOWANCES AND TRAVEL EXPENSES

for the period 1st April 2021 to 31st March 2022

As set out in The Local Authorities (Members' Allowances) (England) Regulations 2003, PART 5, Regulation 31, as soon as reasonably practicable after the end of a year, an authority shall arrange for the publication, for a period of at least 14 days, of a notice in a conspicuous place or places in the area of the authority stating the total sum paid by it in the year to each member in respect of each of the following—(a) parish basic allowance; and (b) parish travelling and subsistence allowance.

Parish Councillors are volunteers and they do not get paid. The payment of Councillors' Allowances is subject to a statutory process which involves a local independent remuneration panel set up by Milton Keynes Council, whose role is to make recommendations as to the level of the various allowances that a Parish Council can pay. The allowance although it is not a salary is treated by HMRC as taxable income and is processed on the Parish Councils payroll software. It is a figure which is calculated to cover the expenses which are normally associated with the basic duties of being a Councillor.
