Good afternoon

We have received a communication from Milton Keynes City Council regarding keeping of chickens. They have received new guidelines from Defra whereby bird keepers need to register any birds they keep. Currently it's mandatory for those who keep 50 or more to register them, **but from October 2024**, **all bird keepers will be responsible for having their birds registered**.

I am attaching the government form that you will need to complete and send to the Animal and Plant Health Agency (APHA), details are at the end of the form. I have completed the parish council's details on the form, but you will need to complete the rest and either send it electronically or post it. If you would like me to print off a copy for you, then please let me know.
